ICAR-CIRCOT Centenary Lecture Series



Mera Gaon Mera Gourav Awareness Programme



• Ginning Training Centre, ICAR-CIRCOT, Nagpur organized an awareness programme under the Mera Gaon Mera Gourav at Village Wathoda, Taluk Kalmeshwar, District Nagpur on January 31, 2024 to encourage the cost effective and appropriate technologies for ecologically safe and sustainable clean cotton picking and quality-based marketing of cotton. The aim of the programme was to sensitize the farmers on cleanliness to prevent contamination in cotton to improve the grade of Indian cotton and thereby to increase the farmer's income. Dr. S.V. Ghadge, Principal Scientist educated the farmers about the cotton stalk biomass logistic and its value addition to get additional benefits to the farmers. Er. D.U. Patil, Chief Technical Officer explained about practices to be followed while picking, storage, handling and transportation of cotton. About 40 farmers from the village participated in the programme.
